## ABOUT THE WARSASH ASSOCIATION

Warsash Association members are current and ex-Officer Cadets, senior students and staff of today's Warsash Maritime Academy, an integral part of the Warsash School of Maritime Science and Engineering, as well as its predecessor establishments including the School of Navigation.

The Association was formed in 1984 and the membership has more than doubled in size to 515 members worldwide since 2009. We have Branches in Australia, New Zealand and North America (USA & Canada combined) and members in about 12 countries. It is run by an Executive Committee in the UK and three Branch committees.

Annual events are held in the UK and by our three overseas Branches. These include golf tournaments, two and three-day social events in different locations (generally a port), and in the UK a Remembrance Ceremony and a Christmas Lunch. In addition local Groups formed anywhere in the world arrange their own informal gatherings from time to time. WA officers attend the Warsash School of Maritime Science and Engineering Passing-out Ceremonies in the UK where we present annual awards to Officer Cadets.

A large proportion of our members are ex-cadets from the 1940 – 1971 era but nowadays most new joiners were at Warsash from the 1970s to the present day. This includes about 50 members who were Officer Cadets since 2012.

We enjoy an excellent relationship with the Warsash School of Maritime Science and Engineering.

The UK membership fee is a modest £15 per year which includes our 36-page All Hands journal (members are encouraged to use an electronic version), with comparable fees in our overseas Branches. All recent and most old journal editions since 1949 can be downloaded by members from our website.

There is no charge for Officer Cadets to join until they have passed their Certificate of Competency.
